Details

Food waste bags will be available for £1.30 per roll of 25 bags. The trial will be from 24 July 2017 and a decision will be made by Resource Efficient Solutions and Fife Sports & Leisure Trust in March 2018 on whether to continue.

Standard delivery

The delivery of 3 rolls of food waste bags per year to Fife's householders will continue as normal and is unaffected by this additional service. This trial will allow households to purchase additional bags if they wish.

Road Report

Continuaton of road closure - Clayton

The temporary road closure is being continued until 16/09/17. Notice will be advertised in the St Andrews Citizen on 28/07/17 and notices will also be posted on site.

Temporary Road Closure

WHERE? Main Street, Leuchars at Meadow Road junction. Access for emergency services and residents will be maintained. Access for pedestrians is unaffected. The alternative route for HGVs, high and wide loads is via A914, A92, A91 and A919. The alternative route for all other vehicular traffic is via A919, A914 and A91. WHEN? Sun. 13/08/17 at 22.00hrs to Mon. 14/08/17 at 05.45hrs. WHY? To allow repairs to Scottish Water manhole in the carriageway to be carried out in safety

Road Closure - St Michaels to Lucklaw Hill

The work starts on the 7th August and is expected to last 2 weeks. School buses will be allowed access through the site from the 16th August. A free shuttle bus will run between Balmullo and Leuchars for passengers using service buses during the road closure. Information will be provided at bus stops
