

*Councillor Connor report to the CC*

**Leuchars Station car park**

Following requests local residents we have looked at options for accommodating drop off points for users of Leuchars Rail Station. Layby on station road was looked at but insufficient land available under Fife Council ownership and the cost could not be accommodated within the new car park budget. We have also looked at the roundabout/centre of the bus turning area but this would cause too much conflict between pedestrians and vehicles. Layout of older car park would leave a much greater walk distance as the closest spaces are to be used for disabled parking spaces and EV charging. We have also received requests from users that they would like disabled parking spaces in the new car park.

Therefore after due consideration we are proposing the following layout to accommodate 4 drop off spaces (20mins limited waiting) and 2 disabled parking spaces next to the motorcycle parking on the right hand side (overlooking Station Road) within the new car park.
